Peninsula's 2-1-1 referral service receives more than 1,000 calls per month from people looking for answers when they simply don't know where to start. But the *future of our regional 2-1-1 system is now in YOUR hands*. Due to recent funding changes for the support of our regional Crisis Clinic, that work is being moved from Kitsap Mental Health Services to Volunteers of America in Everett.

Unfortunately, this leaves a critical funding gap. Dollars that once supported both the Crisis Clinic, and in part, our regional 2-1-1 system, will no longer be available. This program, that began as Info-Link nearly 20 years ago, provided information and referrals to more than 14,000 callers in 2018. It is a vital link for our community. United Way of Kitsap County is working to bring 2-1-1 services into our office to ensure that this critical resource remains local, up-to-date, and available in our community – both for day-to-day health and human services and also for disasters.
